Our organization voted at its general membership meeting on September 9, 2010 to participate in the Neighborhood Conservation Program and proceed with preparing a Neighborhood Conservation Plan for our neighborhood. It is understood that we will make every effort to complete a survey and neighborhood inventory within a twelve month period and will establish a timetable for plan preparation.

Our primary and alternate representatives to the NCAC will be:

1. Jennifer Zeien (primary)
2. Heather Schaefer (alternate)

We understand that attendance at NCAC meetings is a prerequisite for active participation and project funding, and will assure that a neighborhood representative attends these meetings, which are held on the second Thursday of each month.

The North Rosslyn Civic Association boundaries are as follows: Wilson Boulevard, Lee Highway, North Quinn Street, and Arlington Ridge Road, inclusive of the Key Bridge Marriott, Gateway Park, and connecting parcels of land. Within these geographic boundaries, there are two distinct sub-neighborhoods: (1) the Colonial Terrace enclave consisting primarily of single-family homes, duplexes, townhomes, low-rise condominium and apartment buildings, and (2) the Rosslyn core, a mixed office and residential area characterized by office buildings, some in excess of 300 feet in height, residential high-rise apartments and condominiums, and hotels.
